DISCUSSION Senator Resignation/Replacement Appointment

Senator Joey McNamara resigned from the University; President Beaver, as authorized in the Senate Bylaws, designated as his replacement Hope Young, staff member in the Office of Marketing and Communications, to represent the Athletics/President's Office area. Senator Hemphill made a motion to approve the appointment; Senator Hardee seconded the motion. Motion passed.

DISCUSSION New Business/Open Floor Discussion

Mark Johnson, Assistant Director of University Police Department, shared information about current ULMPD initiatives including the new ULM SAFE App and upcoming Everbridge Warhawk Alert system decommissioning, the establishment of a FEMA/American Red Cross Campus Emergency Response Team (CERT) at ULM, and continuing Active Shooter Training opportunities for faculty, staff, and students on campus.

Jeanette Robinson, Digital Media Specialist in the Office of Marketing and Communication, noted that OMC published a new University Newsletter today, distributed to all employees via Warhawk mail.

DISCUSSION Guest Speaker

Dr. Alberto Ruiz, newly appointed Vice President for Academic Affairs, introduced himself to Staff Senate. He expressed his belief in the importance of Staff Senate and its purpose, and he explained that he will always make decisions based on the best interest of students.

He updated Senate on the current budget outlook, discussed ideas about scholarship offer strategies, confirmed intentions to continue with operating margins calculations for academic programs, and expressed interest in strengthening ULM's relationship with Delta Community College.
