- > 2002 the University has lost the connection with the community and high schools. Enrollment had been on a 8 year decline. When Dr. Cofer accepted the offer to become president he had made a point to meet with every high school within the first 100 days. It was at that point, Dr. Cofer learned the high school students did not want anyone to know they were going to the university.
- > Two weeks later Lisa was moved into the role of Recruitment and Admissions. Enrollment was turned around at this time.
- > 2002 we went to an open administration institution. Then in 2005, we moved into a selected admission institution. The intention was to improve our retention and graduation rate. We knew we could not survive on students just from Northeast Louisiana.
- In 2002, we had 1100 freshmen. Our ACT average was 18.8. Our percentage of freshmen students to receive TOPS was around the 30 percentile mark and my last year over Enrollment was around 1400 freshman students, ACT average was 23 and TOPS was around 80 percentile. We were moving the needle on the quantity of students but also moving the needle on the quality of students. Selling the Student experience.
