- Performance evaluations have been moved to July and will no longer be "360" style
- Construction of the new food service and student use facility, The HUB, begins July 1, with groundbreaking planned for that day at 10:00 am
- Sugar Hall interior renovation to begin soon, will provide one location for all campus-based therapy clinics
- A generator has been installed in Schulz Cafeteria so that meals can be available for students during power outages
- Deferred maintenance is occurring in several campus locations.
